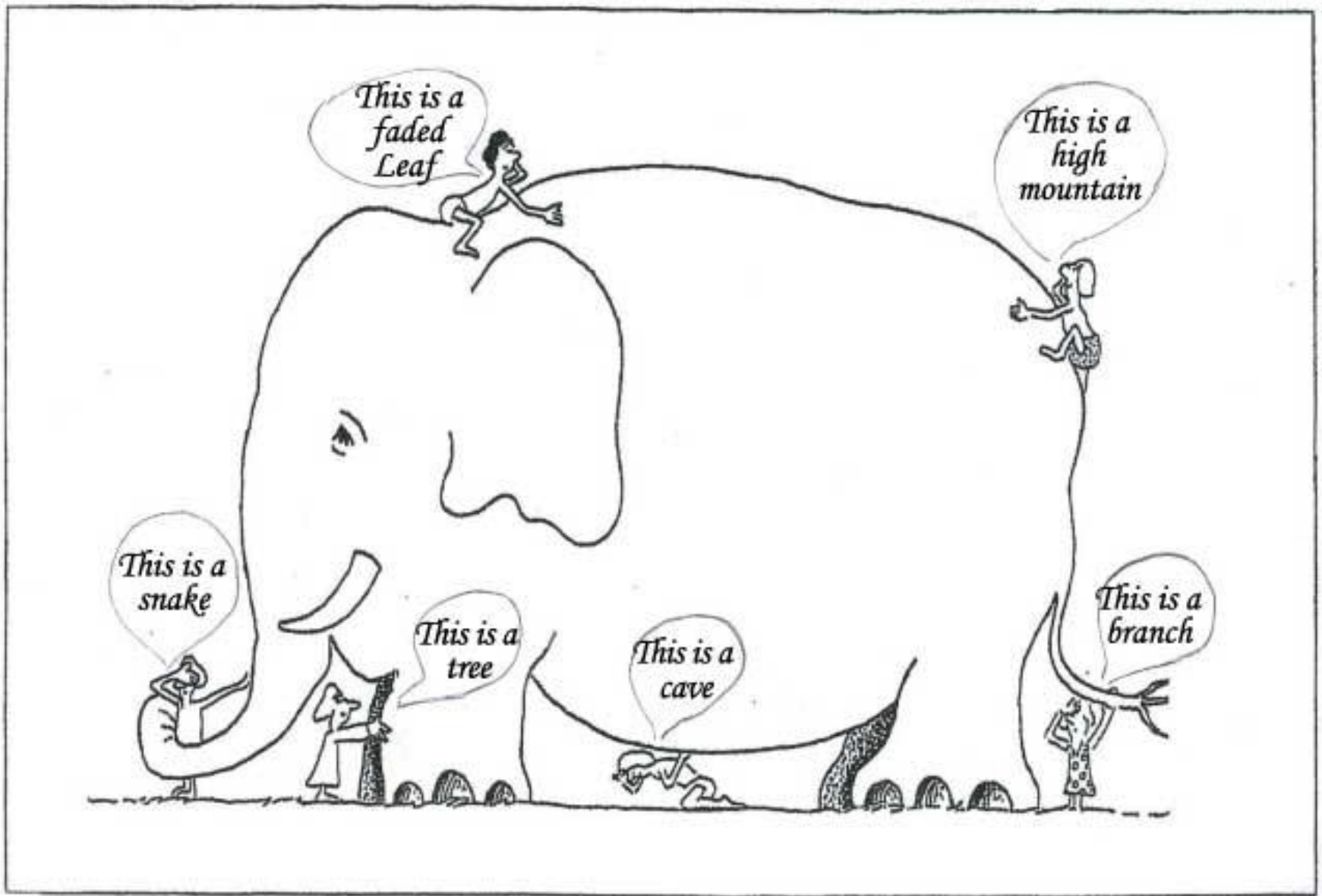

SCORING COMMITTEE RECAP



VERIFYING SELECTIONS: CRITERIA

ISSUE

Rate on a scale of 1-5, 5 being the highest rating

SIZE OF PROBLEM	URGENCY	SEVERITY	IMPACT ON OTHERS
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PEARL TEST: Yes or No? Yes=1, No=0

<u>Propriety:</u> Is an intervention suitable? Is it feasible to impact in 5 years? Will it duplicate efforts?	<u>Economics:</u> Does it make economic sense to address this problem?	<u>Acceptability:</u> Will this community accept an emphasis on his problem and will they accept the proposed interventions to follow?	<u>Resources:</u> Are funding and other resources available or potentially available?	<u>Legality:</u> Are there laws to allow intervention to be implemented? If not, is it worthwhile to expend the time, energy, resources, etc.?

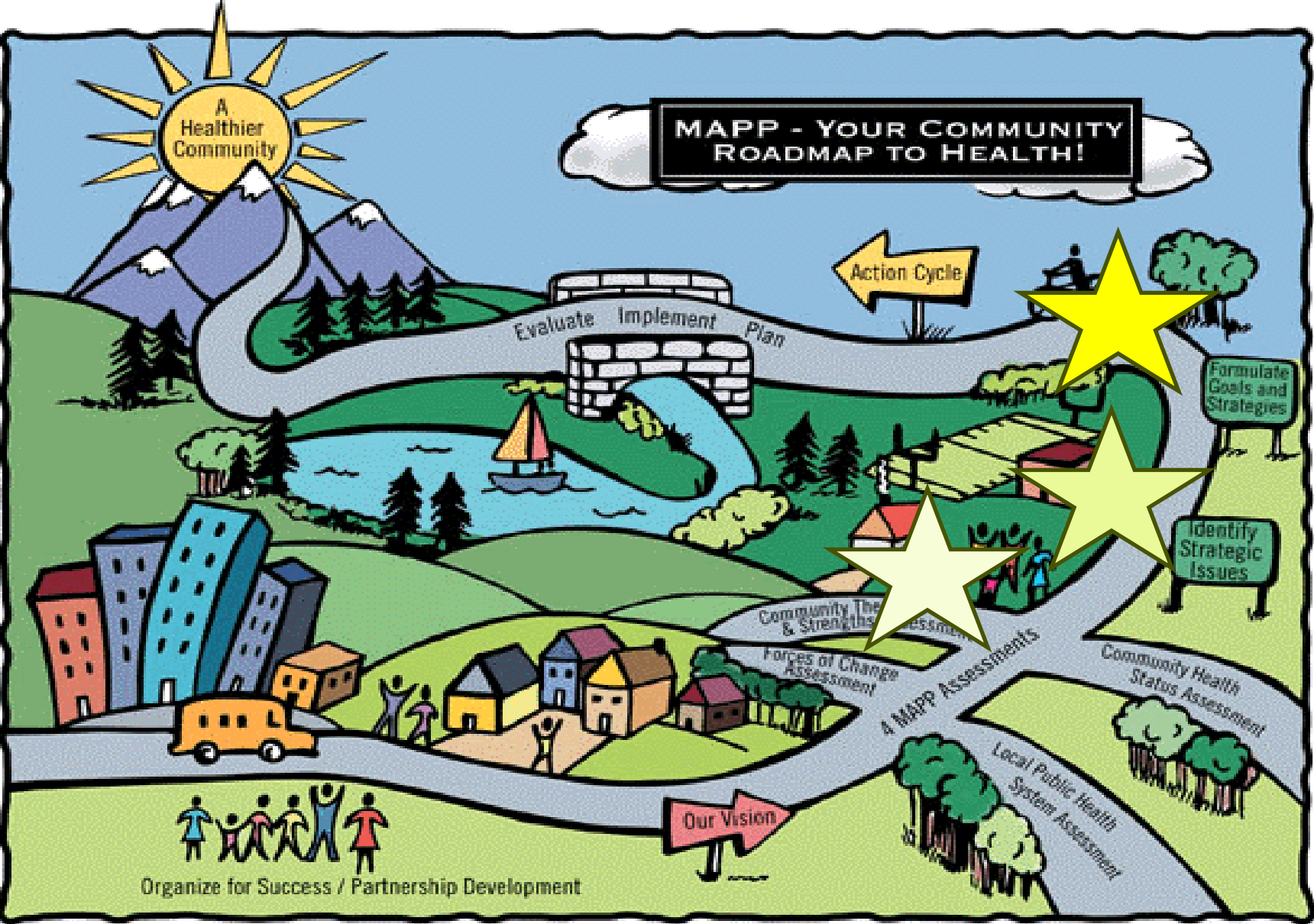
- Partners felt ownership of strategic issues.
